# **Endings and beginnings**

Grace and peace to you all.

Our story of Christianity is one of death and life. Of endings and beginnings. Of a cycle of life that has at its center God. We know this most fully when we consider the Holy Week story of Jesus. Of his arrest, and death, and resurrection. Jesus rising to life after being laid in the tomb is the central aspect of our faith story. While we often understand this story in regards to our own stories, and that our own deaths will not our final word. Life eternal with God is the promise of resurrection. But the Church also proclaims that this promise of resurrection, of new life, is meant for the here and now.

Things in our ministries and world have beginnings and endings, endings and beginnings. Years ago Gloria Dei made a decision to host a food pantry in our building to help serve the needs of our neighbors and community. I am grateful that this happened, the people fed, and the donations to the pantry to support this ministry. It was an endeavor of faith. However, the past few years we have seen a marked shift to our number of guests who have come to the pantry, dropping drastically to where some days we have had no visitors when open. This has led to much of the food in our pantry to become outdated and cleared out.

Why the drop in visits? I doubt it is because there are less hungry people. As we wondered and discussed and implemented different ideas to get the word out about our pantry, the numbers remained low. With having a number of other pantry options in our area, our volunteers who help organize and staff the pantry started wondering if maybe our time and resources might be more faithfully put towards other ways of supporting our community. The special needs drive for the Barbara Kettle Gundlach shelter we are doing in March is an example of this effort.

So after conversation and prayer amongst these volunteers and the church council, we have decided to wind down our pantry and close it. As was the decision to start the pantry, closing it is also an endeavor of faith.

We heard Jesus a few weeks ago in John's Gospel say: "unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it will not bear fruit." We take this action with hopes of bearing new fruit, with the time and resources that had been used towards the pantry finding new avenues to be impactful in our community and supporting our neighbors. Putting together more needs drives for local ministries. Supporting other local pantries. Or coming together with local partners to bring Feeding America mobile pantries into our community.

What fruit might God help us grow and share in this season?
