January 2024. Pastor Brahm's Annual Report.

May God's grace surround us, Christ's love lift us, and the Spirit's inspiration sustain us in our journey's of faith and life.

This past year has been unique in the life of our congregation and community, and my life personally. Through it all God continues to be faithful, in the midst of the challenges and the opportunities.

- 1. Worship: Worship continues to be the central thing we do together as the people of God. I am grateful for the opportunities to worship with this community, for the musicians and volunteers who help make worship happen, and to consider how God is present and active in our lives. As we gather together, God's Word brings us words of comfort and challenge. My hope is that our worship and our proclamation of the Word together gets us to think, to ask questions, and to wonder together what God is up to. Sometimes this means challenging our own preconceived ideas about God and this world. My hope is that all might feel welcome in our worship, but also know our style of worship might be unfamiliar to those who might be new. How might we better invite and welcome those who are new to our space and community in the ways that we worship?
- 2. **Education:** We have a nice group of kids who come on Sunday mornings to learn and play together. Our largest group is in the K-2 age range. Our middle and high school kids gather twice a month, and we have moved to scheduling it month by month because schedules are changing for our families. We did a few different adult ed gatherings, using books, devotions during Lent and Advent, as well as the weekly text study that happens on Sunday mornings in between services. In these ways we continue to study and look for God's Word.
- 3. **Finlandia's Closing:** This event certainly had an impact on our community and congregation, as our connections over Finlandia's history have been many. This congregation helped support this community in processing, grieving, and giving thanks for the legacy of this institution. I give thanks for the many years of dedication to this community and the students who learned at this institution. The spiritual aspect of vocation is important to our Lutheran identity, and Finlandia for years helped young and old alike learn about how God was calling them into the world.
 - Personally, my spouse's employment being tied to the university caused some uncertain moments in our lives, but am thankful that Good Shepherd was able to call Sarah as pastor, which has led to some partnerships and sharing with our friends in Houghton.
- 4. **Stewardship:** We had our first intentional stewardship emphasis this past fall in a number of years. This was to help talk about what we do together in our shared ministry, and how the congregations support financially and through volunteer hours makes our ministry happen. We finished the year strong, and I am grateful for the support we receive from so many to make this ministry work.

5. Partnerships: We are blessed with a number of partnerships, a highlight of which was our partnership with Temeke Lutheran Church in Dar es Salaam in Tanzania. I was able to visit these friends in October through the support of the congregation. We renewed our connections, and made new ones. One worry from our friends is the loss of the yearly Finlandia Servant Leader trip as a way to stay connected. We will have to find new ways of connection, and technology has made communication much easier. We also hope some young adults from Temeke might be able to work summers at Fortune Lake, as well as inviting a group from Temeke to visit us again in the near future.

Fortune Lake continues to be a valued partner in our faith formation endeavors. We had around 20 youth attend camp last summer, had almost 50 kids come to VBS amongst 4 congregations, with another 12 teens who helped volunteer that week. We see this partnership carrying over into 2024, as we will again work together for VBS and have 25 youth attending the National Youth Gathering in New Orleans amongst a number of congregations in the Copper Country. This includes 12 that are connected with Gloria Dei.

Our ecumenical connections also branch out into shared worship experiences with First United Methodist and Church of the Resurrection in Hancock, as well as Good Shepherd Lutheran and Portage Lake United Church in Houghton this past year. A church gathering called UP Wild also started up in 2023 as a joint effort between Lutherans and Episcopalians and anyone else who wanted to experience God in an intentional community in the wilderness.

What does that bring for 2024? We will continue to build on some of these partnerships, and continue to ask questions of God and what God is up to in our community. We have scheduled some long-awaited technology upgrades for our in person and online worshipping experience. We will continue to be open to the Spirit's moving in our midst, and new opportunities. How might God be calling is to worship, fellowship, and serve together?

I continue to lean on the promises of grace and God's presence in the midst of this journey of faith: the ups and downs, the questions and laughter, the times of certainty and the times of doubt. My hope comes most strongly in the promise of God's faithfulness to us and this world God created and continues to re-create.
